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## **IX: SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND NOTIFICATION**

### **GENERAL ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

1. The SWE-Region i scholarship program is open only to paid SWE members that reside or attend a university within Region i.
2. The applicant must not be the current recipient of any renewable SWE Scholarship.
3. The applicant must not be receiving full funding for education from another organization (e.g. Armed forces, fellowship or employer).
4. The applicant must a paid SWE member in Region i (collegiate, professional, or MAL) and must remain in good standing with SWE during the semester the scholarship is awarded.

#### Undergraduate Student Scholarship

- The applicant must be enrolled full-time in an ABET/CSAB accredited engineering program, pursuing a bachelors degree.
- The applicant must be a sophomore, junior, or senior during the 2014-2015 school year.

#### Graduate Student Scholarship

- The applicant must be enrolled full-time and pursuing a masters degree or PhD in an engineering program.
- The applicant must be a graduate student for the entire 2014-2015 school year to be eligible.

#### Part-time Student Scholarship

- The applicant must be enrolled part-time and pursuing a secondary degree.
- The applicant must be a professional in the engineering workplace for the entire 2014-2015 "school year" to be eligible.
- The applicant must have earned their bachelors degree from an ABET/CSAB accredited engineering program.

### **SCHOLARSHIP NOTIFICATION:**
